BLOOMINGTON — Stephen "Steve" Pearson Main passed away February 24, 2017, in Hawaii. He was born in Shelbyville, IN, January 2, 1943, to Claude and Louise Main.



Steve graduated from North Central High School, Butler University, and Ball State University. He served on active duty with the U.S. Navy 1965-1968. He taught music (orchestra) for Tippecanoe Junior High in Lafayette, MSD of Martinsville, and Clay Junior High in Carmel, IN. He was executive director of Habitat for Humanity of Morgan County. After retirement, Steve headed up the REPAIR team for Area 10 in Monroe County, where he did handyman work and built ramps and steps. He was very active at First Presbyterian Church of Martinsville and in recent years, First Presbyterian Church of Bloomington. He was an elder in the Presbyterian Church (USA). Steve was a cellist with the Bloomington Symphony Orchestra.

Steve was very committed to his family, his faith, music, and his community. He received many awards for his participation in music and his communities.

Steve is survived by his wife, Jo Ann (Grossman) Main of Bloomington; his children, Jeff Main and his wife, Joy, of Bloomington and Deborah Mansell and her husband, Frank, of Indianapolis; his sisters, Charlotte Chadwick of Indianapolis, and Sara (John) Stallings of Lafayette; one brother, Robert (Jan) Main of Indianapolis; and four grandchildren, Evan Main, Erin Mansell, Miles Main, and Heather Mansell.
